NOTICE INVITING TENDERS

Sealed tenders on plain paper are hereby invited from the interested parties for the sale of fruit crop of about 400 nos. Mango (Dusheri) fruit trees around boys hostel no.1,2,3,4 & 5 and also the fruit crop of about 150 nos. of Desi mango trees in the Panjab University Campus, Sector-14, Chandigarh for two seasons i.e. for the years 2014 and 2015.

The sealed tenders shall be received by the undersigned in his office up to 11.00 a.m. on 11.02.2014 **by registered post or speed post** and shall be opened at a suitable date as decided by the authorities after 11.02.2014 in the presence of the tenderers or their authorized representatives who may like to be present at that time.

Only the tenders accompanied with the earnest money at the rate of 2% of the cost of the tender will be entertained. The earnest money can be deposited with the undersigned in the shape of demand draft in favour of the Registrar, Panjab University, Chandigarh.

2. Panjab University does not take any responsibility for any postal delay in delivery by Registered/Speed Post or lost in transit of the tender. No tender will be entertained by hand/courier/ Ordinary post.
3. No tender unless accompanied with the earnest money shall be entertained
4. The highest tenderer shall have to deposit Rs.10,000/- as security (Refundable after the season is over).
5. No tree shall be damaged in any way.
6. Fruit shall have to be removed latest by 31st of July of respective year.
7. The undersigned reserves the right to accept or reject any tender without assigning any reason.
8. In case of any dispute the decision of the undersigned shall be final
9. No claim shall be entertained for any loss to the fruit due to natural cause or otherwise.
10. Full amount of the highest bid shall have to be deposited with the State Bank of India (Sector-14 branch) of the University immediately after the opening of the tenders.
11. The mango fruit can be plucked only after the approval of the allotment by the Vice-Chancellor.
